- 34 (a) Whether the recipient is enrolled in and attending school;
- 35 (b) Whether the recipient is employed;

- 1 (c) The situation in the home of the recipient's parents, including 2 but not limited to, whether there is substance abuse or domestic 3 violence in the home and the adequacy of the dwelling; and
- 4 (d) Whether there is a history of physical, emotional, or sexual 5 abuse of the recipient by a person living in or frequenting the 6 recipient's parents' home.
- 7 (3) If, as a result of the assessment, the department becomes aware 8 of a recipient's need for other services that will help the recipient 9 complete high school or achieve economic independence, and be an 10 effective parent, the department shall make every effort to link the 11 recipient with the services, including parenting classes."
