- 19 **Sec. 2.** RCW 79.64.030 and 1988 c 70 s 4 are each amended to read 20 as follows:
- 21 Funds in the account derived from the gross proceeds of leases, 22 sales, contracts, licenses, permits, easements, and rights of way 23 issued by the department and affecting school lands, university lands, agricultural college lands, scientific school lands, normal school 24 25 lands, capitol building lands, or institutional lands shall be pooled 26 and expended by the department solely for the purpose of defraying the 27 costs and expenses necessarily incurred in managing and administering ((public lands of the same trust: PROVIDED, That)) all of the trust 28 lands enumerated in this section. Such funds may be used for similar 29 30 costs and expenses in managing and administering other lands managed by 31 the department((: PROVIDED FURTHER,)) provided that such expenditures that have been or may be made on such other lands shall be repaid to 32 33 the resource management cost account together with interest at a rate determined by the board of natural resources. 34

An accounting shall be made annually of the accrued expenditures 1 ((as regards each)) from the pooled trust funds in the account. In the 2 event the accounting determines that expenditures have been made from 3 moneys derived from ((one category of)) trust lands for the benefit of 4 ((another trust or)) other lands, such expenditure shall be considered 5 a debt ((against the trust benefited)) and ((shall be considered)) an 6 7 encumbrance against the property ((of the trust or trust funds)) 8 benefited, including property held under chapter 76.12 RCW. results of the accounting shall be reported to the legislature at the 9 10 next regular session. The state treasurer is authorized, upon request of the department, to transfer funds between the forest development 11 12 account and the resource management cost account solely for purpose of repaying loans pursuant to this section. 13
