The petition shall set forth a description of the property according to government legal subdivisions or legal plats which is in 24 25 compliance with RCW 35.02.170, and shall be accompanied by a plat which outlines the boundaries of the property sought to be annexed. 26 27 legislative body has required the assumption of all or of any portion of city or town indebtedness by the area annexed, and/or the adoption 28 of a comprehensive plan for the area to be annexed, these facts, 29 together with a quotation of the minute entry of such requirement or 30 requirements shall be set forth in the petition. The signing of an 31 32 outside utility agreement that includes a waiver of a property owner's right not to sign an annexation petition may not be counted as a 33 34 signature on an annexation petition."

7 "Sec. 9. RCW 35A.14.120 and 1989 c 351 s 6 are each amended to 8 read as follows:

Proceedings for initiating annexation of unincorporated territory 9 to a charter code city or noncharter code city may be commenced by the 10 filing of a petition of property owners of the territory proposed to be 11 12 annexed, in the following manner. This method of annexation shall be 13 alternative to other methods provided in this chapter. Prior to the 14 circulation of a petition for annexation, the initiating party or 15 parties, who shall be the owners of not less than ten percent in value, 16 according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property for which annexation is sought, shall notify the legislative 17 body of the code city in writing of their intention to commence 18 annexation proceedings. The legislative body shall set a date, not 19 later than sixty days after the filing of the request, for a meeting 20 21 with the initiating parties to determine whether the code city will 22 accept, reject, or geographically modify the proposed annexation, 23 whether it shall require the simultaneous adoption of a proposed zoning regulation, if such a proposal has been prepared and filed for the area 24 25 to be annexed as provided for in RCW 35A.14.330 and 35A.14.340, and whether it shall require the assumption of all or of any portion of 26 27 existing city indebtedness by the area to be annexed. legislative body requires the assumption of all or of any portion of 28 indebtedness and/or the adoption of a proposed zoning regulation, it 29 shall record this action in its minutes and the petition for annexation 30 shall be so drawn as to clearly indicate these facts. Approval by the 31 32 legislative body shall be a condition precedent to circulation of the There shall be no appeal from the decision of the 33 petition. 34 legislative body. A petition for annexation of an area contiguous to a code city may be filed with the legislative body of the municipality 35 to which annexation is desired. 36 It must be signed by the owners, as

defined by RCW 35A.01.040(9) (a) through (d), of not less than sixty 1 percent in value, according to the assessed valuation for general 2 taxation of the property for which annexation is petitioned: PROVIDED, 3 4 That a petition for annexation of an area having at least eighty percent of the boundaries of such area contiguous with a portion of the 5 boundaries of the code city, not including that portion of the boundary 6 of the area proposed to be annexed that is coterminous with a portion 7 8 of the boundary between two counties in this state, need be signed by 9 only the owners of not less than fifty percent in value according to 10 the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property for which the annexation is petitioned. Such petition shall set forth a 11 description of the property according to government legal subdivisions 12 13 or legal plats and shall be accompanied by a map which outlines the boundaries of the property sought to be annexed. If the legislative 14 15 body has required the assumption of all or any portion of city 16 indebtedness by the area annexed or the adoption of a proposed zoning 17 regulation, these facts, together with a quotation of the minute entry of such requirement, or requirements, shall also be set forth in the 18 19 petition. The signing of an outside utility agreement that includes a waiver of a property owner's right not to sign an annexation petition 20 may not be counted as a signature on an annexation petition." 21
