- 19 and provide technical assistance concerning compliance with the
- 20 agency's laws and rules.
- 21 (2) An employee designated by an agency as a technical assistance
- 22 representative or as a member of a technical assistance unit may not,
- 23 during the period of the designation, have authority to issue orders or
- 24 assess penalties on behalf of the agency. Such an employee who
- 25 provides on-site consultation at an industrial or commercial facility
- 26 and who observes violations of the law shall inform the owner or
- 27 operator of the facility of the violations and provide technical
- 28 assistance concerning compliance. On-site consultation visits by such
