Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 43.20A.360, there shall be a 8 citizens advisory council composed of not less than seven nor more than 9 10 fifteen members((, at least two of whom shall be recovered alcoholics or other recovered drug addicts and two of whom shall be members of 11 12 recognized organizations involved with problems of alcoholism and other drug addiction)). It is the intent of the legislature that the 13 citizens advisory council broadly represent citizens who have been 14 15 recipients of voluntary or involuntary treatment for alcoholism or 16 other drug addiction and who have been in recovery from chemical dependency for a minimum of two years. To meet this intent, at least 17 two-thirds of the council's members shall be former recipients of these 18 services and not employed in an occupation relating to alcoholism or 19 20 <u>drug addiction</u>. The remaining members shall be broadly representative 21 of the community, shall include representation from business and 22 industry, organized labor, the judiciary, and minority groups, chosen 23 for their demonstrated concern with alcoholism and other drug addiction problems. Members shall be appointed by the secretary. In addition to 24 advising the department in carrying out the purposes of this chapter, 25 the council shall develop and propose to the secretary for his or her 26 consideration the rules for the implementation of the chemical 27 dependency program of the department. Rules and policies governing 28 treatment programs shall be developed in collaboration among the 29 council, department staff, local government, and administrators of 30 voluntary and involuntary treatment programs. The secretary shall 31 32 thereafter adopt such rules that, in his or her judgment properly implement the chemical dependency program of the department consistent 33 34 with the welfare of those to be served, the legislative intent, and the public good. 35

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately."
