- 23 To protect children in the public <u>and private</u> schools of this state
- 24 from exposure to the addictive substance of nicotine and cancer-causing
- 25 agents found in environmental tobacco smoke, each school or school
- 26 district ((board of directors)) shall adopt a written policy mandating
- 27 a prohibition on the use of all tobacco products on ((public)) school
- 28 property. A total ban on the use of all tobacco products shall be
- 29 enforced ((by September 1, 1991)) for all public and private schools.
- 30 Schools may provide tobacco cessation information and referral services
- 31 to students in violation of this section, in coordination with local
- 32 <u>health departments and voluntary organizations</u>. The policy may allow

- 1 If a law enforcement officer has a reasonable belief that a student
- 2 has violated the provisions of this section the officer may confiscate
- 3 and destroy any tobacco products in the student's possession.

- 5 effect January 1, 1995.
- 6 (2) Section 3 of this act shall take effect September 1, 1994."
