- 8 (3) The nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) shall
 9 receive the training specified in this subsection. The person
 10 conducting the training must be a registered nurse licensed under
 11 chapter 18.88 RCW. A registered nurse shall not be subject to any
 12 reprisal or disciplinary action for refusing to provide the training
 13 required under this section. Training shall include the following:

- (c) Written instructions for performance of the task for the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) to use as a reference;
 - (d) Instructions to the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) that the task being taught is specific to this client only and is not transferable to other clients or taught to other care providers;
- (e) Documentation of how the task was taught, the teaching 28 outcome, the content and type of instructions left for the nursing 29 30 assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5), evidence that the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) understands risks involved in 31 performing the task and has a plan for how to respond to the 32 consequences, and evidence that the nursing assistant defined in RCW 33 34 18.88A.020(5) was instructed that the task is client-specific and not transferable to other clients or providers; 35
- (f) Performance of the administration of medications or treatments by nursing assistants defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) authorized in this section shall be reviewed at least annually by a registered nurse.

- 1 (4) A registered nurse may delegate administration of 2 gastrostomy, but not nasogastric, tube feedings to a nursing 3 assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) specific to one client under 4 the following conditions:
- 5 (a) The registered nurse shall consider the nature of the task to 6 be provided, its complexity, risk involved, and the necessary skill 7 needed;
- 8 (b) The registered nurse shall assess the client's condition and 9 determine that there is not a significant risk to the client if the 10 nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) performs the task in 11 the absence of direct supervision;
- 12 (c) The registered nurse shall determine how frequently the 13 client's condition shall be reassessed to determine the 14 appropriateness of the continued delegation of the task to a nursing 15 assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5);
- 16 (d) If there is some risk involved to the client, the registered 17 nurse shall determine that the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18 18.88A.020(5) is prepared to respond effectively to the consequences;

- (e) The registered nurse shall assess the ability of the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) to perform the task;
- (f) The registered nurse shall determine the frequency of supervision of the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5);
- (g) The registered nurse shall document the process for deciding that the task can be safely delegated for the specific client to the specific nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5);
- (h) The registered nurse shall document how frequently the client should be reassessed by a registered nurse regarding continued delegation of the task to the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5);
- 30 (i) The responsibility, accountability, and authority of the registered nurse shall be limited to teaching and delegation of 31 administration of gastrostomy tube feeding to the nursing assistant 32 defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5), and the determination of which nursing 33 34 assistants defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) and the number of nursing assistants defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) that must be taught and 35 delegated the task of administration of gastrostomy tube feedings 36 37 shall remain with the registered nurse;

- 1 (j) The number of persons to whom the tasks are taught and 2 delegated shall be limited to the number that can be safely 3 supervised by the registered nurse; and
- 4 (k) The registered nurse shall assure that the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) maintains proficiency in performing the tasks through periodic supervision, and reviews conducted at least annually, by the registered nurse.
- 8 (5) The delegating registered nurse has a responsibility to 9 determine that the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) is indeed competent to perform the delegated act. Nonnursing and 10 managerial persons shall not coerce the registered nurse into 11 compromising client safety by requiring the registered nurse to 12 13 delegate. Both the delegating registered nurse and the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) are accountable for their own 14 15 actions in the delegation process.
- (6) Verification of the current registration of a person holding himself or herself out to be a nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5) and any restrictions relating to the registration shall be the responsibility of the employer of the nursing assistant defined in RCW 18.88A.020(5).
- (7) Development of rules implementing subsections (2), (3), (4), and (5) of this section shall be jointly adopted by the department of social and health services and the state nursing care quality assurance commission.
- 25 (8) A basic core training curriculum on providing care in 26 residential settings for people with developmental disabilities shall 27 be in addition to the specific nursing assistant training specified 28 in this section.
