10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 706.** DEFINITIONS. The definitions in this  
11 section apply throughout sections 707 through 710 of this act unless  
12 the context clearly requires otherwise.

13 (1) "Credential" means regulation of a health professional at the  
14 level of registration, certification, or licensure as defined in  
15 chapter 18.120 RCW.

16 (2) "Department" means the department of health.

17 (3) "Health profession" means a health profession specified under  
18 RCW 18.130.040(2).

19 (4) "Health profession advisory committee" or "advisory committee"  
20 means advisory committees established by the secretary or by law for  
21 health professions cited in RCW 18.130.040(2)(a).

22 (5) "Health profession regulatory board" or "boards" or  
23 "commissions" means the professional regulatory boards or commissions  
24 for health professions cited in RCW 18.130.040(2)(b).

25 (6) "Scope of practice" means the range of diagnosis, treatments,  
26 services, technologies, equipment, and pharmaceuticals that a health  
27 profession is authorized to use.

28 (7) "Secretary" means the secretary of health or the secretary's  
29 designee.

30 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 707.** APPLICABILITY. Except for licensees  
31 governed under chapter 18.39 RCW, the professional review commission  
32 shall have the authority to adopt rules, standards, guidelines, or  
33 policies relating to the scope of practice or the level of

1 credentialing for health professions regulated under RCW 18.130.040 in  
2 accordance with provisions of sections 706 through 710 of this act.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 708.** PROFESSIONAL REVIEW COMMISSION AND LEVEL  
4 OF CREDENTIALING REVIEW PROCESS. (1) A professional review commission  
5 is created within the department of health. The commission shall be  
6 composed of six members, of whom one is the state health officer who  
7 shall chair the committee. The remaining five shall be appointed by  
8 the governor, with the consent of the senate. These members must  
9 demonstrate a broad understanding of health care issues and a  
10 commitment to improving the delivery of health care to all citizens in  
11 Washington state.

12 (2)(a) Initial commission members shall serve four-year terms. The  
13 term of office for commission members after the initial commission is  
14 three years, with the first appointments staggered, two members  
15 appointed for one year, two members appointed for two years, and two  
16 members appointed for three years. Thereafter, members shall be  
17 appointed for three-year terms. A commission member may be removed for  
18 just cause including a finding of fact or more than three unexcused  
19 absences. The governor may appoint a new member to fill a vacancy on  
20 the commission for the remainder of the unexpired term.

21 (b) No commission member appointed by the governor may serve more  
22 than two consecutive terms, whether full or partial.

23 (3) Commission members who are nonstate employees shall be  
24 reimbursed for travel expenses in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and  
25 43.03.060.

26 (4) Members of the commission appointed by the governor may not  
27 have current licenses to practice in any of the professions subject to  
28 regulation and may have no pecuniary interest in any business subject  
29 to regulation by the commission. Members are subject to chapter 42.18  
30 RCW, the executive branch conflict of interest act.

31 (5) The commission shall:

32 (a) Receive applications from new professions seeking credentialing  
33 and make recommendations to the legislature concerning whether a  
34 profession should be credentialed.

35 (b) Authorize the level of credentialing and specify scope of  
36 practice for new professions.

1 (c) Review requests for changes in scope of practice or level of  
2 credentialing for health professions regulated under RCW 18.130.040 in  
3 accordance with provisions of sections 706 through 710 of this act.

4 (d) Require that a party requesting changes in scope of practice or  
5 level of credentialing submit information relevant to such decisions  
6 pursuant to chapter 18.120 RCW.

7 (e) Direct staff at the department to conduct an analysis of the  
8 request for change in scope of practice, or a level of credentialing,  
9 using a fair and impartial review of the facts, and authorize that the  
10 application be granted or denied based on criteria in RCW 18.120.030.  
11 In the event that an application is deemed frivolous by the  
12 professional review commission, the applicant will be charged the cost  
13 of processing and reviewing the request.

14 (f) Review the rules and other decisions of the health professional  
15 regulatory boards to determine whether such rules or decisions have the  
16 effect of altering the scope of practice of that profession. If the  
17 professional review commission deems that a board has acted in a manner  
18 to change a scope of practice, the commission may reverse, vacate,  
19 revoke, nullify, or modify the rules or decisions. All rules,  
20 standards, guidelines, or policies of any kind relating to a  
21 profession's scope of practice of a health profession regulatory board,  
22 whether adopted before or after the effective date of this act, are  
23 subject to review by the professional review commission.

24 (g) Authorize changes be made in training, education, and other  
25 requirements for health professions specified under RCW 18.130.040 to  
26 enable changes in scope of practice or levels of credentialing that are  
27 authorized under sections 706 through 710 of this act. This shall  
28 include, when appropriate, adoption of uniform provisions under chapter  
29 18.122 RCW.

30 (h) Use the professional expertise of the health profession  
31 regulatory boards, health profession regulatory commissions, and  
32 advisory committees and others to fulfill its responsibilities under  
33 sections 706 through 710 of this act.

34 (i) Use expert witnesses when expertise on a specific application  
35 is needed.

36 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 709.** AUGMENT OR REMOVE. (1) Effective July 1,  
37 1995, the professional review commission may augment or remove

1 functions of a health profession's scope of practice or make changes in  
2 the level of credentialing of a health profession.

3 (2) The professional review commission, notwithstanding any  
4 provision of this title to the contrary, shall establish additional  
5 training, education, and other requirements for health professions  
6 specified under RCW 18.130.040 as made necessary by the changes in  
7 scope of practice or levels of credentialing or professions newly  
8 credentialed that are authorized under sections 706 through 710 of this  
9 act. This shall include, when appropriate, application of uniform  
10 administrative provisions under chapter 18.122 RCW. In the event that  
11 a rule by the professional review commission directly conflicts with  
12 statutory provisions in this title, the commission shall submit for  
13 legislative consideration, proposed legislation that would remove  
14 statutory conflict.

15 (3) All processes by the professional review commission under  
16 sections 706 through 710 of this act shall be subject to the provisions  
17 of chapter 34.05 RCW.

18 (4) Rules adopted by the professional review commission under this  
19 section are subject to review by the joint administrative rules review  
20 committee of the legislature. If the joint administrative rules review  
21 committee does not direct the professional review commission to  
22 reconsider the rule within forty-five days of publication, the rule is  
23 deemed effective.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 710.** CRITERIA FOR USE BY THE PROFESSIONAL  
25 REVIEW COMMISSION. (1) In considering changes in the scope of practice  
26 of a health profession, the professional review commission shall  
27 consider at least the following factors:

28 (a) Whether a serious risk to the public's life, health, or safety  
29 will occur if the scope of practice remains unchanged.

30 (b) Whether there is a clear benefit to the public in changing the  
31 scope of practice of a health profession.

32 (c) Whether the current education and training requirements of the  
33 health profession are sufficient to assure the safe delivery of the  
34 health care services that will result from the change of scope of  
35 practice.

36 (d) Whether there is a sufficient availability of training and  
37 education programs to meet the demand for training that will result  
38 from the change in scope of practice.

1 (e) How the change in the scope of practice will effect the  
2 availability and cost of health care services.

3 (f) Whether the change in level of credentialing, or scope of  
4 practice improves access and affordability to health care services with  
5 proven success in promoting public health.

6 (2) In considering changes in the level of credentialing of a  
7 health profession cited in RCW 18.130.040(2), the professional review  
8 commission shall use at a minimum the criteria specified in chapter  
9 18.120 RCW.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 711.** A new section is added to chapter 18.122  
11 RCW to read as follows:

12 TRANSITION AND STUDY. (1) The department shall establish a health  
13 care governance project. Participants in this project shall be  
14 determined by the secretary. The secretary is encouraged to include  
15 representatives from boards and commissions, health professions  
16 resource plan statutory committee, health care providers, insurers, the  
17 public, the legislature, higher education, the health services  
18 commission, and other appropriate state agencies dealing with health  
19 systems reform. A report to the legislature shall be submitted by the  
20 project by December 1, 1995. The report shall include timelines for  
21 implementation and proposed language for consideration in the 1996  
22 legislative session.

23 (2) The purpose of the project is to recommend further improvements  
24 to the system for the credentialing and disciplining of health  
25 professionals in the state of Washington.
