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5 On page 2, after line 30, insert the following:

6 **"COMMUNITY SELECTION OF LOCAL EDUCATION PROGRAM**

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 101.** (1) Each school district in the state
8 shall develop educational programs designed to provide each student in
9 the district with the opportunity to achieve the student learning goals
10 under section 202 of this act.

11 (2) Each school district board of directors may authorize a school
12 or schools in the district to participate in the performance-based
13 education system developed under RCW 28A.630.885, following a public
14 hearing by the school board and adoption of a motion stating the intent
15 and scope of participation. The adopted motion shall require that
16 schools authorized and choosing to participate in the performance-based
17 education system shall administer the tests required under RCW
18 28A.230.190, 28A.230.230, and 28A.230.240 for at least five school
19 years following the date of first participation in the performance-
20 based system. A copy of the adopted motion shall be transmitted to the
21 superintendent of public instruction by the district board of
22 directors. After a public hearing, the school board may repeal the
23 motion stating the intent and scope of participation and shall transmit
24 a copy of the motion repealing the intent and scope of participation to
25 the superintendent of public instruction.

26 (3) The state schools for the deaf and blind, pursuant to
27 subsection (2) of this section, may participate in the performance-
28 based system developed under RCW 28A.630.885 and may apply for grants
29 under section 401 of this act.

30 (4) Each school district board of directors may adopt procedures to
31 permit parents to remove their children from courses of instruction
32 offered primarily to meet student learning goal number four listed
33 under section 201 of this act.

34 (5) Nothing under chapter . . . , Laws of 1993 (this act) shall
35 affect the provisions of RCW 28A.230.070(4) that allow students not to
36 participate in AIDS prevention education, and state board of education

1 rules that allow students an excusal from planned instruction in sex
2 education or human sexuality.

3 (6) For schools not authorized or choosing to participate in the
4 performance-based education system developed under RCW 28A.630.885,
5 sections 501 through 507 of chapter 141, Laws of 1992 shall not apply.

6 **PART II"**

7 Renumber remaining parts, sections and subsections consecutively
8 and correct any internal references accordingly.

9 EFFECT: Reinserts language permitting districts to authorize
10 schools to opt into the performance-based system, and provides that
11 schools not opting in shall remain subject to certain basic education
12 act provisions otherwise repealed effective 1998 under chapter 141,
13 Laws of 1992.

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
