- (j) Demonstrate a commitment to delivering a greater variety of high quality products at lower cost through manufacturing innovations such as concurrent engineering, flexible manufacturing, and just-intime production.

(2) The task force shall be composed of the following members: The 1 executive director of the commission for efficiency and accountability 2 in government or his or her designee, who shall serve as chair; the 3 4 governor or the governor's designee; the director of the department of general administration or his or her designee; a representative from 5 each caucus of the house of representatives to be appointed by the 6 7 speaker of the house of representatives; a representative from each 8 caucus of the senate to be appointed by the president of the senate; a 9 representative from a major state-wide public employee union; two 10 representatives from major state-wide private sector unions; three representatives from a major state-wide business organization that 11 represents a cross section of private sector industry; and two 12 13 representatives from the general public."
