- (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, it shall 9 be unlawful for any person who is not a citizen of the United States((7 10 or who has not declared his intention to become a citizen of the United 11 12 States,)) to carry or have in his or her possession at any time any 13 ((shotgun, rifle, or other)) firearm, without first having obtained a 14 license from the director of licensing, and such license is not to be 15 issued by the director of licensing except upon the certificate of the 16 consul domiciled in the state and representing the country of such alien((, that he)). The consul shall present a certified copy of the 17 criminal history from the alien's country, and attest that the alien is 18 a responsible person ((and)). Upon the payment ((for the license)) of 19 20 the sum of ((fifteen)) twenty-three dollars((: PROVIDED, That)) by the 21 alien, the director of licensing may issue the license.
- (2) If the consul has not provided a certificate of criminal history within ninety days after request by the alien, the alien may apply for a concealed pistol license under RCW 9.41.070 if the alien has been a resident of this state for not less than two years.
- (3) This section shall not apply to Canadian citizens resident in 26 27 a province which has an enactment or public policy providing substantially similar privilege to residents of the state of Washington 28 29 and who are carrying or possessing weapons for the purpose of using 30 them in the hunting of game while such persons are in the act of hunting, or while on a hunting trip, or while such persons are 31 32 competing in a bona fide trap or skeet shoot or any other organized contest where rifles, pistols, or shotguns are used ((as to weapons 33 34 used in such contest)). Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow aliens to hunt or fish in this state without first having 35 obtained a ((regular)) nonresident hunting or fishing license. 36

1 <u>(4)</u> Any person violating the provisions of <u>subsection (1) of</u> this 2 section shall be guilty of a ((<u>misdemeanor</u>)) <u>class C felony</u>."
