There is hereby established a "public disclosure commission" which 8 shall be composed of ((five)) seven members who shall be appointed by 9 the governor, with the consent of the senate . All appointees shall be 10 persons of the highest integrity and qualifications. No more than 11 12 three members shall have an identification with the same political party. The original members shall be appointed within sixty days after 13 14 The term of each member shall be five years except January 1, 1973. 15 that the ((original five members shall serve initial terms of one, two, 16 three, four, and five)) two new members appointed after the effective date of this act shall serve initial terms of two and four years, 17 respectively, as designated by the governor. 18 No member of the 19 commission, during his or her tenure, shall (1) hold or campaign for 20 elective office; (2) be an officer of any political party or political 21 committee; (3) permit his or her name to be used, or make 22 contributions, in support of or in opposition to any candidate or 23 proposition; (4) participate in any way in any election campaign; or (5) lobby or employ or assist a lobbyist: PROVIDED, That a member or 24 25 the staff of the commission may lobby to the limited extent permitted by RCW 42.17.190 on matters directly affecting this chapter. No member 26 27 shall be eligible for appointment to more than ((one)) two full terms. A vacancy on the commission shall be filled by the governor within 28 thirty days of the vacancy ((by the governor)), with the consent of the 29 30 senate and the appointee shall serve for the remaining term of his or <u>her</u> predecessor. A vacancy shall not impair the powers of the 31 32 remaining members to exercise all of the powers of the commission. ((Three)) Four members of the commission shall constitute a quorum. 33 34 The commission shall elect its own ((chairman)) chair and adopt its own rules of procedure in the manner provided in chapter 34.05 RCW. 35

1 member of the commission may be removed by the governor, but only upon 2 grounds of neglect of duty or misconduct in office.

Members shall be compensated in accordance with RCW 43.03.250 and in addition shall be reimbursed for travel expenses incurred while engaged in the business of the commission as provided in RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060. The compensation provided pursuant to this section shall not be considered salary for purposes of the provisions of any retirement system created pursuant to the general laws of this state."
