Facilities of public office or agency include, but are not limited to, use of stationery, 18 postage, machines, and equipment, use of employees of the office or 19 20 agency during working hours, vehicles, office space, publications of the office or agency, and clientele lists of persons served by the 21 22 office or agency((: PROVIDED, That)). The ((foregoing)) provisions of 23 this section shall not apply to the following activities:

(((+1+))) (a) Action taken at an open public meeting by members of an elected <u>local government</u> legislative body to express a collective decision, or to actually vote upon a motion, proposal, resolution, order, or ordinance, or to support or oppose a ballot proposition so long as (((+a+))) (i) any required notice of the meeting includes the title and number of the ballot proposition, and ((+b+)) (ii) members of the legislative body or members of the public are afforded an approximately equal opportunity for the expression of an opposing view; ((+2+)) (b) A statement by an elected <u>local government</u> official in support of or in opposition to any ballot proposition at an open press conference or in response to a specific inquiry;

 $((\frac{3}{3}))$  (c) Activities which are part of the normal and regular conduct of the office or agency.

- (2) No agency or official or employee of any agency may disburse 1 funds in the form of dues or membership fees to an entity that uses any 2 portion of the dues or membership fees for the support of or opposition 3 4 to a ballot proposition. This subsection does not apply to funds deducted from a public employee's pay and forwarded to a bargaining 5 representative pursuant to RCW 41.56.110."
