Facilities of 17 18 public office or agency include, but are not limited to, use of 19 stationery, postage, machines, and equipment, use of employees of the 20 office or agency during working hours, vehicles, office space, publications of the office or agency, and clientele lists of persons 21 served by the office or agency((: PROVIDED, That)).
