12 the programs. School districts shall demonstrate that they have  
13 applied for applicable federal funds before applying for funds under  
14 this subsection.

15 (2) To the extent funds are appropriated, the superintendent of  
16 public instruction shall increase the state support for school  
17 breakfasts and lunches. Funds appropriated under this subsection are  
18 intended to increase participation by eligible students in school food  
19 programs, and shall be used solely to enhance school breakfast and  
20 lunch programs."

1        "NEW SECTION.   **Sec. 17.**   The department of social and health  
2 services shall form a task force with representatives from the  
3 financial services industry and grocery industry to discuss initiation  
4 of a future pilot project using electronic benefit transfer technology  
5 for the food stamp program.  The task force shall research the status  
6 of federal implementation efforts, as well as the effectiveness of  
7 pilot programs in other states.  The department shall report to the  
8 appropriate standing committees of the legislature on the task force's  
9 findings by December 1, 1995.

10       Private industry members of the task force shall serve voluntarily,  
11 without compensation or reimbursement of expense."

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
