5 On page 28, after line 8, insert the following:

6 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 409. A new section is added to chapter 9.41  
7 RCW to read as follows:

8 Upon conviction of any person of any offense that disqualifies the  
9 offender from ownership of a pistol the court shall: (1) Immediately  
10 revoke the concealed pistol license of the offender, if any; (2) order  
11 the immediate surrender of the license to the court; (3) destroy the  
12 license, unless an appeal of the conviction is timely filed, in which  
13 case the court shall retain possession of the license until a final  
14 determination of the appeal; and (4) notify the department of licensing  
15 of the revocation.

16 If the license has not otherwise expired, the court shall restore,  
17 without cost, the license of a person whose conviction is reversed on  
18 appeal. The person shall also be eligible for relicensing without  
19 consideration of the original conviction. Upon restoration, the court  
20 shall immediately notify the department of licensing.

21 NEW SECTION. Sec. 410. A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW  
22 to read as follows:

23 Upon receipt of notice from the court under section 409 of this  
24 act, the department shall correct its records to reflect the revocation  
25 or restoration of the concealed pistol license."

26 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any  
27 internal references accordingly.
