5 On page 2, after line 10, insert the following:

6 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 49.12 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) Minors under age sixteen may not be employed during school
9 hours, except by special permission from school officials as outlined
10 in RCW 28A.225.010 and 28A.225.080. Minors under age sixteen may not
11 be employed during the school year before seven a.m. nor after seven
12 p.m. on days immediately preceding a school day nor after nine p.m. on
13 days not immediately preceding a school day. During school vacations
14 minors under age sixteen may not work past nine p.m.

15 (2) Minors under age sixteen may not be employed more than three
16 hours per day on school days, nor more than eighteen hours per week
17 during school weeks. During school vacations, a minor under age
18 sixteen may not be employed more than forty hours per week.

19 (3) A minor may not be employed more than eight hours per day nor
20 more than six days in any one week. Minors employed past eight p.m. in
21 service occupations must be supervised by a responsible adult who is
22 required to be on the premises. During the school year, a minor may
23 not be employed for more than forty hours per week.

24 (4) A minor may not be employed on consecutive nights, both of
25 which precede a school day, unless working no later than ten p.m.

26 (5) A minor may not be employed more than five hours without a meal
27 period of at least thirty minutes.

28 (6) A minor employee shall be given a rest period of at least ten
29 minutes in every four-hour period of employment, except as otherwise
30 provided by law.

31 (7) An agency may not adopt rules under this title that further
32 restrict minor working hours."
