16 "(2) Any armored car service, as defined in RCW 81.80.010, that  
17 files the documents required in this section is exempt from any  
18 requirement to obtain any further authority under this title or Title  
19 81 RCW solely for purposes of acting in the capacity of an armored car  
20 service.

21 **Sec. 2.** RCW 81.80.010 and 1989 c 60 s 1 are each amended to read  
22 as follows:

23 The definitions set forth in this section apply throughout this  
24 chapter.

25 (1) "Person" means and includes an individual, firm, copartnership,  
26 corporation, company, or association or their lessees, trustees, or  
27 receivers.

28 (2) "Motor vehicle" means any truck, trailer, semitrailer, tractor,  
29 dump truck which uses a hydraulic or mechanical device to dump or  
30 discharge its load, or any self-propelled or motor-driven vehicle used  
31 upon any public highway of this state for the purpose of transporting

1 property, but not including baggage, mail, and express transported on  
2 the vehicles of auto transportation companies carrying passengers.

3 (3) "Public highway" means every street, road, or highway in this  
4 state.

5 (4) "Common carrier" means any person who undertakes to transport  
6 property for the general public by motor vehicle for compensation,  
7 whether over regular or irregular routes, or regular or irregular  
8 schedules, including motor vehicle operations of other carriers by rail  
9 or water and of express or forwarding companies, and excluding armored  
10 car services.

11 (5) "Contract carrier" includes all motor vehicle operators not  
12 included under the terms "common carrier" and "private carrier" as  
13 herein defined in paragraph (4) and paragraph (6), and further includes  
14 any person who under special and individual contracts or agreements  
15 transports property by motor vehicle for compensation, but excludes  
16 armored car services.

17 (6) A "private carrier" is a person who transports by his own motor  
18 vehicle, with or without compensation therefor, property which is owned  
19 or is being bought or sold by such person, or property of which such  
20 person is the seller, purchaser, lessee, or bailee where such  
21 transportation is incidental to and in furtherance of some other  
22 primary business conducted by such person in good faith.

23 (7) "Motor carrier" means and includes "common carrier," "contract  
24 carrier," "private carrier," and "exempt carrier" as herein defined.

25 (8) "Exempt carrier" means any person operating a vehicle exempted  
26 from certain provisions of this chapter under RCW 81.80.040.

27 (9) "Vehicle" means every device capable of being moved upon a  
28 public highway and in, upon, or by which any person or property is or  
29 may be transported or drawn upon a public highway, excepting devices  
30 moved by human or animal power or used exclusively upon stationary rail  
31 or tracks.

32 (10) "Commercial zone" means an area encompassing one or more  
33 cities or towns and environs adjacent thereto established pursuant to  
34 RCW 81.80.400.

35 (11) "Terminal area" means an area including one or more cities or  
36 towns and environs adjacent thereto established pursuant to RCW  
37 81.80.400.

38 (12) "Common carrier" and "contract carrier" include((s)) persons  
39 engaged in the business of providing, contracting for, or undertaking

1 to provide transportation of property for compensation over the public  
2 highways of the state of Washington as brokers or forwarders, but do  
3 not include armored car services.

4 (13) "Armored car service" means a company operating primarily to  
5 transport currency, coins, negotiable instruments, or precious metals."
