- (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the state finance committee may not enter into an agreement or contract for the services of an underwriter or service provider that has made a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW to a candidate for the office of state treasurer during the two-year period immediately preceding the effective date of such agreement or contract.
- 24 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the state 25 finance committee may not enter into an agreement or contract for the 26 services of an underwriter or service provider that will not, as a condition of entry to the agreement or contract, certify (a) that it 27 has not made a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW to a 28 29 candidate for the office of state treasurer during the two-year period 30 immediately preceding the effective date of such agreement or contract, and (b) that it will not make a contribution reportable under chapter 31 42.17 RCW to a candidate for the office of state treasurer during the 32 period beginning on the date of entry into the agreement or contract 33 34 and ending one year after the date the agreement or contract has been revoked or otherwise become inoperative. 35

  - (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the state investment board may not enter into an agreement or contract for the services of a service provider that has made a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW to a candidate for the office of state treasurer during the two-year period immediately preceding the effective date of such agreement or contract.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the state 31 32 investment board may not enter into an agreement or contract for the 33 services of a service provider that will not, as a condition of entry 34 to the agreement or contract, certify (a) that it has not made a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW to a candidate for the 35 36 office of state treasurer during the two-year period immediately preceding the effective date of such agreement or contract, and (b) 37 that it will not make a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW 38

- to a candidate for the office of state treasurer during the period beginning on the date of entry into the agreement or contract and ending one year after the date the agreement or contract has been revoked or otherwise become inoperative.
  - (3) The state investment board may not enter into any partnership agreement with any person who has made a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW to a candidate for the office of state treasurer during the two-year period immediately preceding the effective date of such agreement.
- 10 (4) The state investment board may not enter into a partnership agreement with any person that will not, as a condition of entry to the 11 agreement, certify (a) that it has not made a contribution reportable 12 13 under chapter 42.17 RCW to a candidate for the office of state treasurer during the two-year period immediately preceding the 14 15 effective date of such agreement or contract, and (b) that it will not make a contribution reportable under chapter 42.17 RCW to a candidate 16 17 for state office during the period beginning on the date of entry into the agreement and ending one year after the date the agreement or 18 19 contract has been revoked or otherwise become inoperative.
- 20 (5) This section does not apply to agreements or contracts entered 21 into through competitive solicitation or with respect to any reportable 22 contribution made before January 1, 1995.
