- The purpose of this section is to set forth the powers of the 9 department to regulate the withdrawal or diversion of public waters and 10 water or water rights related thereto including regulation based on 11 12 dates of priority or other pertinent factors. Regulatory actions taken 13 under this section shall be based on examination and determination by 14 the department or the court, as applicable, of the various water rights 15 involved according to the department's records and other records and 16 pertinent facts. The powers set forth in this section may be exercised 17 whether or not a general adjudication relating to the water rights involved has been conducted. 18
- 19 (1) In a regulatory situation (a) where a water right or all water 20 rights proposed for regulation by the department, as well as any right or rights of a senior priority that the proposed regulation is designed 21 22 to protect, is or are embodied in a certificate or certificates issued 23 under RCW 90.03.240, 90.03.330, 90.38.040, 90.42.040, or 90.44.060 or a permit or permits issued pursuant to RCW 90.03.290 or 90.44.060; or 24 25 (b) where a flow or level has been established by rule pursuant to chapter 90.22 or 90.54 RCW; or (c) where it appears to the department 26 27 that public waters are being withdrawn without any right or other appropriate authority whatsoever, the department in its discretion is 28 authorized to regulate the right or rights under either RCW 43.27A.190 29 30 or subsection (2) of this section.
- (2) In a regulatory situation where one or more of the water rights proposed for regulation by the department, as well as any right or rights of a senior priority that the proposed regulation is designed to protect, is not or are not embodied in a permit or certificate as described in subsection (1) of this section, the department, as its sole and exclusive power to regulate, is authorized to bring an

- 1 appropriate action at law or in equity, including seeking injunctive
- 2 relief, as it may deem necessary. Where actions are brought in a state
- 3 court, the actions shall be initiated in the superior court of the
- 4 county where the point or points of diversion of the water right or
- 5 rights proposed for regulation are located. If the points of diversion
- 6 are located in more than one county, the department may bring the
- 7 action in a county where a point of diversion is located.
- 8 (3) Nothing in this section authorizes the department to accomplish
- 9 a general adjudication of water rights proceeding or the substantial
- 10 equivalent of a general adjudication of water rights. The exclusive
- 11 procedure for accomplishing a general adjudication of water rights is
- 12 under RCW 90.03.110 through 90.03.245 or 90.44.220.
- 13 (4) Nothing in this section shall have an impact on RCW 90.14.130
- 14 or 90.14.200.
- 15 (5) This section does not in any way modify regulatory powers
- 16 previously placed with the department except as provided in subsections
- 17 (1) and (2) of this section.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The legislature shall examine and recommend
- 19 changes to state policies relating to water rights, water use, and
- 20 water doctrine and report the recommendations to the 1995 legislature.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 22 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 23 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 24 effect immediately."
