### HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS

**Majority Report:** Do pass as amended. Signed by 18 members: Representatives Locke, Chair; Valle, Vice Chair; Appelwick; Basich; Dellwo; Dorn; Dunshee; G. Fisher; Jacobsen; Lemmon; Leonard; Linville; Peery; Rust; Sommers; Wang; Wineberry; and Wolfe.

**Minority Report:** Do not pass. Signed by 9 members: Representatives Silver, Ranking Minority Member; Carlson, Assistant Ranking Minority Member; Ballasiotes; Cooke; Morton; Sehlin; Sheahan; Stevens; and Talcott.

**Background:** The state government operates on the basis of a fiscal biennium that begins on July 1 of each odd numbered year.

**Summary of Amended Bill:** The 1993-95 omnibus appropriations act.

**Amended Bill Compared to Substitute Bill:** The amended bill makes appropriations for the 1993-95 biennium. The state general fund total is \$16.1 billion.
