HOUSE COMMITTEE ON CAPITAL BUDGET

Majority Report: Do pass as amended. Signed by 14 members: Representatives Wang, Chair; Ogden, Vice Chair; Sehlin, Ranking Minority Member; McMorris, Assistant Ranking Minority Member; Brough; Eide; R. Fisher; Jacobsen; Jones; Moak; Romero; Silver; Sommers and B. Thomas.

Minority Report: Do not pass. Signed by 1 member: Representative Heavey.

Background: Every two years the Legislature adopts a biennial capital budget approving the expenditure of state moneys for capital purposes. On even-numbered years, a supplemental capital budget is adopted to address emergency needs for school construction, institutions of higher education, and other state facilities.

Summary of Bill: The total appropriations in the 1993-1995 capital budget are reduced \$53.6 million. The state bonded portion of the capital budget is reduced \$6.8 million and the other funding sources are reduced \$46.8 million.

Fiscal Note: Not requested. Details of appropriation changes are in the budget notes.

Effective Date: The bill contains an emergency clause and takes effect immediately.
