Minority Report: Do not pass. Signed by 9 members: Representatives Silver, Ranking Minority Member; Ballasiotes; Cooke; G. Fisher; Foreman; Sehlin; Sheahan; Stevens and Talcott.

Background: The state government operates on the basis of a fiscal biennium that begins on July 1 of each odd-numbered year. A biennial operating budget was enacted in the 1993 legislative session.

Summary of Bill: The 1993-95 operating appropriations act is amended.

Appropriation: See bill.

Effective Date: The bill contains an emergency clause and takes effect immediately.
