Background: Currently the feed, seed, seedlings, fertilizer, and spray materials sold to farmers are exempt from the sales and use tax.

Summary of Bill: Pollination agents, cutter bees, are specifically added to the list of agricultural purchases that are exempt from the sales and use tax.
