**Brief Description:** Relating to the capital budget.

**HOUSE COMMITTEE ON CAPITAL BUDGET**

**BACKGROUND:**

Every two years the Legislature adopts a biennial capital budget approving the expenditure of state moneys for capital purposes. On even-numbered years, a supplemental capital budget is adopted to address emergent needs for school construction, institutions of higher education, and other state facilities.

**SUMMARY:**

Appropriation adjustments are made to the 1993-95 capital budget.

The general fund bond supported appropriations made for new projects in the 1993-95 biennial capital budget are reduced by \$22,904,505. Changes in reappropriations and other fund adjustments reduce the total 1993-95 capital appropriations by \$35,382,322.

**HOUSE AMENDMENT(S) :**

The total appropriations in the 1993-1995 capital budget are reduced \$53.6 million. The state bonded portion of the capital budget is reduced \$6.8 million and the other funding sources are reduced \$46.8 million.
