1 AN ACT Relating to education; adding a new section to chapter 84.52
2 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.500 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 84.52 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) In addition to the maximum dollar amount that may be levied by
7 any school district for maintenance and operation support pursuant to
8 RCW 84.52.0531, a supplemental levy may be made by any school district
9 when authorized to do so by the electors of such school district at a
10 special or general election.

11 (2) A supplemental levy shall not exceed three percent of the
12 district's levy base as determined by RCW 84.52.0531(4) and may be used
13 for community service purposes including:

14 (a) Preschool and day care activities;

15 (b) Senior programs;

16 (c) Community programs serving children and adults; and

17 (d) Other nonschool-related activities as approved by the school
18 district.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.500
2 RCW to read as follows:
3 Approval of a supplemental levy as authorized by section 1 of this
4 act does not entitle a school district to additional local effort
5 assistance funds as defined by RCW 28A.500.010.
