1 AN ACT Relating to obstructing a public servant; amending RCW
2 9A.76.020; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.76.020 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.76.020 are
5 each amended to read as follows:

6 Every person who, (1) without lawful excuse shall refuse or
7 knowingly fail to make or furnish any statement, report, or information
8 lawfully required of him or her by a public servant, or (2) in any such
9 statement or report shall make any knowingly untrue statement to a
10 public servant, or (3) shall knowingly hinder, delay, or obstruct any
11 public servant in the discharge of (~~his~~) official powers or duties;
12 shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
