1            AN ACT Relating to fines for violation of emergency water use  
2 restrictions; and amending RCW 57.08.170.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 57.08.170 and 1991 c 82 s 7 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            A water district may adopt a water conservation plan and emergency  
7 water use restrictions. The district may enforce a water conservation  
8 plan and emergency water use restrictions by imposing a fine as  
9 provided by resolution for failure to comply with any such plan or  
10 restrictions. The commissioners may provide by resolution that if a  
11 fine for failure to comply with the water conservation plan or  
12 emergency water use restrictions is delinquent for a specified period  
13 of time, the district shall (~~certify the delinquency to the treasurer~~  
14 ~~of the county in which the real property is located and~~) serve notice  
15 of the delinquency on the subscribing water customer who fails to  
16 comply, and the fine is then a separate item for inclusion on the bill  
17 of the party failing to comply with the water conservation plan or  
18 emergency water use restrictions.

1 Water districts shall collect fines under RCW 57.08.080 and  
2 57.08.090.
