1 AN ACT Relating to well drilling; and adding a new section to
2 chapter 18.104 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.104 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) For each new well that is established, a well fee shall be
7 remitted by the water well contractor to the department along with the
8 well report required under RCW 18.104.050 as follows:

9 (a) For a new water well with a minimum top casing diameter of less
10 than twelve inches, one hundred dollars;

11 (b) For a new water well with a minimum top casing diameter of
12 twelve inches or greater, two hundred dollars;

13 (c) For a new resource protection, observation, or monitoring well,
14 or for a geotechnical soil boring, one hundred dollars for the first
15 well or boring and fifty dollars for each additional well or boring at
16 the same site; or

17 (d) For construction and decommissioning a dewatering well, one
18 hundred dollars for the first well and fifty dollars for each
19 additional dewatering well at the same site.

1 (2) Fees shall be paid by check or money order. Cash shall not be
2 accepted.
