1 AN ACT Relating to industrial insurance permanent partial
2 disability awards; amending RCW 51.32.080; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 51.32.080 and 1988 c 161 s 6 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1)(a) Until July 1, 1993, for the permanent partial disabilities
7 here specifically described, the injured worker shall receive
8 compensation as follows:

10 Of leg above the knee joint with short thigh stump	
11 (3" or less below the tuberosity of ischium).....	\$54,000.00
12 Of leg at or above knee joint with functional stump.....	48,600.00

4 (b) Beginning on July 1, 1993, compensation under this subsection
5 shall be computed as follows:

6 (i) Beginning on July 1, 1993, the compensation amounts for the
7 specified disabilities listed in (a) of this subsection shall be
8 increased by thirty-five percent; and

9 (ii) Beginning on July 1, 1994, and each July 1 thereafter, the
10 compensation amounts for the specified disabilities listed in (a) of
11 this subsection, as adjusted under (b)(i) of this subsection, shall be
12 readjusted to the nearest cent which bears the ratio of its original
13 amount that exists between the index for 1992 and the index for the
14 calendar year prior to the year of adjustment. For the purposes of
15 this subsection, "index" means the same as the definition in RCW
16 2.12.037(1).

17 (2) Compensation for amputation of a member or part thereof at a
18 site other than those ((above)) specified in subsection (1) of this
19 section, and for loss of central visual acuity and loss of hearing
20 other than complete, shall be in proportion to that which such other
21 amputation or partial loss of visual acuity or hearing most closely
22 resembles and approximates. Compensation shall be calculated based on
23 the adjusted schedule of compensation in effect for the respective
24 time period as prescribed in subsection (1) of this section.

25 (3)(a) Compensation for any other permanent partial disability not
26 involving amputation shall be in the proportion which the extent of
27 such other disability, called unspecified disability, shall bear to
28 ((that above)) the disabilities specified in subsection (1) of this
29 section, which most closely resembles and approximates in degree of
30 disability such other disability, and compensation for any other
31 unspecified permanent partial disability shall be in an amount as
32 measured and compared to total bodily impairment(~~(: PROVIDED, That in~~
33 ~~order)).~~ To reduce litigation and establish more certainty and
34 uniformity in the rating of unspecified permanent partial disabilities,
35 the department shall enact rules having the force of law classifying
36 such disabilities in the proportion which the department shall
37 determine such disabilities reasonably bear to total bodily impairment.
38 In enacting such rules, the department shall give consideration to, but

1 need not necessarily adopt, any nationally recognized medical standards
2 or guides for determining various bodily impairments.

3 (b) Until July 1, 1993, for purposes of calculating monetary
4 benefits under (a) of this subsection, the amount payable for total
5 bodily impairment shall be deemed to be ninety thousand dollars(~~(~~
6 ~~PROVIDED, That))~~). Beginning on July 1, 1993, for purposes of
7 calculating monetary benefits under (a) of this subsection, the amount
8 payable for total bodily impairment shall be adjusted as follows:

9 (i) Beginning on July 1, 1993, the amount payable for total bodily
10 impairment under this section shall be increased to one hundred twenty-
11 one thousand five hundred dollars; and

12 (ii) Beginning on July 1, 1994, and each July 1 thereafter, the
13 amount payable for total bodily impairment prescribed in (b)(i) of this
14 subsection shall be adjusted as provided in subsection (1)(b)(ii) of
15 this section.

16 (c) Until July 1, 1993, the total compensation for all unspecified
17 permanent partial disabilities resulting from the same injury shall not
18 exceed the sum of ninety thousand dollars(~~(~~
19 ~~PROVIDED FURTHER, That in~~
20 ~~ease))~~). Beginning on July 1, 1993, total compensation for all
21 unspecified permanent partial disabilities resulting from the same
22 injury shall not exceed a sum calculated as follows:

23 (i) Beginning on July 1, 1993, the sum shall be increased to one
24 hundred twenty-one thousand five hundred dollars; and

25 (ii) Beginning on July 1, 1994, and each July 1 thereafter, the sum
26 prescribed in (b)(i) of this subsection shall be adjusted as provided
27 in subsection (1)(b)(ii) of this section.

28 (4) If permanent partial disability compensation is followed by
29 permanent total disability compensation, any portion of the permanent
30 partial disability compensation which exceeds the amount that would
31 have been paid the injured worker if permanent total disability
32 compensation had been paid in the first instance, shall be deducted
33 from the pension reserve of such injured worker and his or her monthly
34 compensation payments shall be reduced accordingly.

35 ~~((+3))~~ (5) Should a worker receive an injury to a member or part
36 of his or her body already, from whatever cause, permanently partially
37 disabled, resulting in the amputation thereof or in an aggravation or
38 increase in such permanent partial disability but not resulting in the
39 permanent total disability of such worker, his or her compensation for
such partial disability shall be adjudged with regard to the previous

1 disability of the injured member or part and the degree or extent of
2 the aggravation or increase of disability thereof.

3 (~~(4)~~) (6) When the compensation provided for in subsections (1)
4 (~~and (2)~~) through (3) of this section exceeds three times the average
5 monthly wage in the state as computed under the provisions of RCW
6 51.08.018, payment shall be made in monthly payments in accordance with
7 the schedule of temporary total disability payments set forth in RCW
8 51.32.090 until such compensation is paid to the injured worker in
9 full, except that the first monthly payment shall be in an amount equal
10 to three times the average monthly wage in the state as computed under
11 the provisions of RCW 51.08.018, and interest shall be paid at the rate
12 of eight percent on the unpaid balance of such compensation commencing
13 with the second monthly payment(~~(:—PROVIDED, That)~~). However, upon
14 application of the injured worker or survivor the monthly payment may
15 be converted, in whole or in part, into a lump sum payment, in which
16 event the monthly payment shall cease in whole or in part. Such
17 conversion may be made only upon written application of the injured
18 worker or survivor to the department and shall rest in the discretion
19 of the department depending upon the merits of each individual
20 application(~~(:—PROVIDED FURTHER, That)~~). Upon the death of a worker
21 all unpaid installments accrued shall be paid according to the payment
22 schedule established prior to the death of the worker to the widow or
23 widower, or if there is no widow or widower surviving, to the dependent
24 children of such claimant, and if there are no such dependent children,
25 then to such other dependents as defined by this title.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
27 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
28 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
29 effect immediately.

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
