1 AN ACT Relating to conservation tariffs allowing transfer of  
2 payment obligations to successive property owners; and adding a new  
3 section to chapter 80.28 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 80.28 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7 Upon request by an electrical company, the commission may approve  
8 a tariff schedule that contains rates or charges for energy  
9 conservation measures, services, or payments provided to individual  
10 property owners or customers. Any such tariff schedule shall provide  
11 for agreements between the electrical company and the property owner or  
12 customer receiving services at the time the conservation measures,  
13 services, or payment are initially provided. Any such tariff schedule  
14 may also provide for the payment of the rates or charges over a period  
15 of time and for the application of the payment obligation to successive  
16 property owners or customers at the premises where the conservation  
17 measures or services were installed or performed or with respect to  
18 which the conservation payments were made. The electrical company  
19 shall record a notice of any such payment obligation in the records

1 maintained by the county auditor under RCW 65.04.030. The commission  
2 may prescribe by rule other methods by which the electrical company  
3 shall notify property owners or customers of any such payment  
4 obligation.
