1 AN ACT Relating to liquified petroleum gas containers; and adding  
2 a new section to chapter 78.52 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 78.52 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6 A person shall not fill a liquified petroleum gas container without  
7 the consent of the owner of the container. The owner of a leased or  
8 rented container shall not unreasonably refuse to consent to having a  
9 container filled. If the owner of the container leases or rents the  
10 container, the owner of the container shall not be liable for personal  
11 injury or property damage that results from the filling of the  
12 container by a person other than the owner or the owner's employee or  
13 agent. For purposes of this section, a liquified petroleum gas  
14 container means any container of one hundred gallons water capacity or  
15 larger. Nothing in this section affects the liability of an owner for  
16 injury or damage resulting from acts or omissions related to the

1 construction, transportation, installation, removal or maintenance of  
2 a container or related to any other act or omission other than filling  
3 a container.
