1 AN ACT Relating to waiver of injunction bonds if a person's health  
2 or life would be jeopardized; and amending RCW 7.40.080.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 7.40.080 and 1957 c 51 s 9 are each amended to read as  
5 follows:

6 No injunction or restraining order shall be granted until the party  
7 asking it shall enter into a bond, in such a sum as shall be fixed by  
8 the court or judge granting the order, with surety to the satisfaction  
9 of the clerk of the superior court, to the adverse party affected  
10 thereby, conditioned to pay all damages and costs which may accrue by  
11 reason of the injunction or restraining order. The sureties shall, if  
12 required by the clerk, justify as provided by law, and until they so  
13 justify, the clerk shall be responsible for their sufficiency. The  
14 court in its sound discretion may waive the required bond in situations  
15 in which a person's health or life would be jeopardized.
