1 AN ACT Relating to contributions to candidates for insurance
2 commissioner; and amending RCW 48.30.110.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 48.30.110 and 1982 c 181 s 18 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) No insurer ((or)), fraternal benefit society, insurance agent,
7 insurance broker, insurance solicitor, insurance adjuster as defined in
8 RCW 48.17.050, insurance education provider, or insurance premium
9 finance company doing business in this state shall directly or
10 indirectly pay or use, or offer, consent, or agree to pay or use any
11 money or thing of value for or in aid of any candidate for the office
12 of insurance commissioner; nor for reimbursement or indemnification of
13 any person for money or property so used.

14 (2) Any individual who violates any provision of this section, or
15 who participates in, aids, abets, advises, or consents to any such
16 violation, or who solicits or knowingly receives any money or thing of
17 value in violation of this section, shall be guilty of a gross
18 misdemeanor and shall be liable to the insurer or society for the
19 amount so contributed or received.

1 (3) For the purposes of subsection (1) of this section, "insurance
2 agent or broker" means any insurance agent or broker whose gross
3 revenue in the form of commission is more than twenty-five percent of
4 the total gross revenue of that particular person or business.
