1 BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
2 STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:

3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state there
4 shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state for their
5 approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to the
6 Constitution of the state of Washington by adding a new section to read
7 as follows:

8 Article XXXVIII, section 1. The legislature may enact a curfew
9 prohibiting persons under the age of eighteen years from being in
10 public places during certain hours of the day.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause
12 notice of the foregoing constitutional amendment to be published at
13 least four times during the four weeks next preceding the election in
14 every legal newspaper in the state.
