1            AN ACT Relating to periodic adjustments of the state minimum wage;  
2 amending RCW 49.46.020; and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 49.46.020 and 1989 c 1 s 2 are each amended to read as  
5 follows:

6            (1) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees who  
7 has reached the age of eighteen years wages at a rate of not less than  
8 (~~three dollars and eighty-five cents per hour except as may be~~  
9 ~~otherwise provided under this section. Beginning January 1, 1990, the~~  
10 ~~state minimum wage shall be~~) four dollars and ((~~twenty-five~~)) ninety  
11 cents per hour.

12            (2) The director shall by regulation establish the minimum wage for  
13 employees under the age of eighteen years.

14            NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act shall take effect January 1, 1994.
