1            AN ACT Relating to nonprofit organizations providing credit  
2 services; adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; and creating a new  
3 section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7            This chapter does not apply to nonprofit organizations in respect  
8 to amounts derived from provision of the following services:

9            (1) Presenting individual and community credit education programs  
10 including credit and debt counseling;

11            (2) Obtaining creditor cooperation allowing a debtor to repay debt  
12 in an orderly manner;

13            (3) Establishing and administering negotiated repayment programs  
14 for debtors; or

15            (4) Providing advice or assistance to a debtor with regard to  
16 subsection (1), (2), or (3) of this section.

17            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.** (1) Nothing in section 1 of this act may be  
18 construed to imply that a person exempt from tax under this section was

1 engaged in a business activity taxable under this chapter prior to the  
2 introduction or enactment of this act.  
3 (2) This act shall be applied retroactively.

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
