1 TO THE HONORABLE BILL CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, The federal tax reform act of 1986 put additional
9 financial stress on the taxpayers of the state of Washington by phasing
10 out the retail sales tax deduction; and

11 WHEREAS, Taxpayers in other states may deduct major state taxes in
12 determining federal income tax; and

13 WHEREAS, Congress could easily relieve this situation by restoring
14 the full deduction;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the United
16 States Congress amend the federal tax reform act of 1986 to restore the
17 deduction of retail sales tax under the federal income tax.

18 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
19 transmitted to the Honorable Bill Clinton, President of the United
20 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the

1 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
2 Washington.
