- AN ACT Relating to food fish; adding new sections to chapter 75.10
- 2 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) Persons who fish for food fish for
- 5 personal use may possess no more than thirty salmon or steelhead in the
 - aggregate at one time, in any form, whether fresh, canned, frozen, or
- otherwise preserved.

- 8 (2) Persons who fish for food fish for personal use may only catch
- 9 and retain a combined total of thirty salmon or steelhead per year.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** It is unlawful to sell, barter, or trade
- 11 salmon or steelhead, caught in this state for personal use, in
- 12 Washington state or another state. This limitation applies to all
- 13 forms of salmon and steelhead, whether fresh or processed.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act are each added
- 15 to chapter 75.10 RCW.
