- 1 TO THE HONORABLE BILL CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, Harbor seals and sea lion populations have greatly
- 9 expanded in recent years due to absolute protection afforded them under
- 10 the Federal Marine Mammals Protection Act; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Seals and sea lions are active predators upon anadromous
- 12 fish such as salmon and steelhead trout; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Anadromous fish populations are significantly reduced in
- 14 numbers throughout Washington state and some stocks have been listed as
- 15 threatened or endangered species; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In order to allow certain salmon and steelhead populations
- 17 to recover to, and be sustained at, viable levels it will be necessary
- 18 to have more flexibility to actively manage seals and sea lions in
- 19 identifiable areas where they cause unacceptable mortality levels in
- 20 specific fish runs; and

- WHEREAS, The well-known situation of "Hershall the seal lion", at the Ballard Locks in Seattle, is an excellent example of sea mammal predation that is seriously harming a particular anadromous fish run and which has yet to be thwarted by nonlethal means; and
- 5 WHEREAS, A long-term member of the Washington State Senate, who 6 recently passed away, Senator A.L. "Slim" Rasmussen, had long 7 championed the last resort solution to the "Hershall" problem, lethal 8 removal; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The lethal removal of seals and sea lions is currently 10 prohibited under the Federal Marine Mammals Protection Act in most all cases; and
- 12 WHEREAS, It is time that the federal government allow that 13 predacious seals and sea lions be killed in order for salmon and 14 steelhead to be allowed a reasonable chance to survive;
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the 16 President and Congress will recognize the wisdom of Senator A.L. "Slim" 17 Rasmussen and modify the Marine Mammal Protection Act to provide for reasonable, balanced, and prudent population levels of seals and sea 18 19 lions in the state of Washington and also provide for the active management of abundant populations at set levels determined with modern 20 wildlife management science by federal and state management agencies, 21 including the use of lethal removal when and where necessary. 22
- BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately transmitted to the Honorable Bill Clinton, President of the United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of Washington.
