1            WHEREAS, Washington state is a member of the Pacific Northwest  
2 Economic Region Agreement; and

3            WHEREAS, The delegate council of the Pacific Northwest Economic  
4 Region consists of legislators from Washington state and from other  
5 participating states and provinces; and

6            WHEREAS, The legislature intends to encourage and support the  
7 cooperative activities of the Pacific Northwest Economic Region  
8 Agreement;

9            NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of  
10 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That a joint  
11 select committee on the Pacific Northwest Economic Region Agreement be  
12 established to:

13            (1) Initiate, review, and evaluate proposals considered or to be  
14 considered by the Pacific Northwest Economic Region or any committee or  
15 council formed as a part of the Pacific Northwest Economic Region;

16            (2) Review, evaluate, and propose uniform legislation to further  
17 the goals of the Pacific Northwest Economic Region; and

18            (3) Make recommendations to the legislature and to the governor  
19 regarding joint regional efforts and such other public policy issues as  
20 would be of mutual benefit to the parties to the Pacific Northwest  
21 Economic Region; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee consist of the  
2 legislators appointed as delegates and alternates to the Pacific  
3 Northwest Economic Region; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Senate committee services and the  
5 House of Representatives office of program research provide staffing to  
6 the committee.
