Brief Description: Making the property of a convicted person acquired as a result of the crime subject to seizure and forfeiture.

HB 1640-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/10/93)

Designates the procedures to be employed to effect a seizure and forfeiture of property.

Designates the distribution of proceeds of any forfeiture action.

Declares that the provisions of the act are supplemental and do not limit rights or remedies otherwise available.
