Brief Description: Prohibiting tax exempt nonprofit organizations from political activity.

HB 1949-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/13/93)

Declares that nonprofit organizations should remain neutral with respect to activities that affect political campaigns on behalf of, in support of, or in opposition to, a political candidate or group of political candidates.

Allows nonprofit organizations to rent their properties to other organizations for candidate events.
