**HB 2810-S - DIGEST**

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

- Provides for civil service reform.
- Establishes procedures and requirements for collective bargaining agreements.
- Establishes the position of director of personnel and designates the duties of the position.
- Provides for the comprehensive review of the personnel classification system.
- Authorizes the purchase of services by contract with individuals or businesses in specified circumstances.
- Abolishes the personnel appeals board and transfers its duties and powers to the personnel resources board.
- Provides collective bargaining reform.
- Authorizes the right to strike in specified circumstances.
- Designates unfair labor practice procedure.
- Creates the state employment relations commission.
- Repeals RCW 41.50.804.
- Repeals provisions of chapters 41.06 and 41.64 RCW.
