3 On page 2, line 7, strike "70.94.775" and insert "section 2 of  
4 this act"

6 On page 2, after line 12, insert the following:

7 "Sec. 2. RCW 70.94.775 and 1991 c 199 s 410 are each amended  
8 to read as follows:

9 No person shall cause or allow any outdoor fire:

10 (1) Containing garbage, dead animals, asphalt, petroleum  
11 products, paints, rubber products, plastics, or any substance other  
12 than natural vegetation that normally emits dense smoke or  
13 obnoxious odors. Agricultural heating devices that otherwise meet  
14 the requirements of this chapter shall not be considered outdoor  
15 fires under this section. The burning of paper, cardboard, or  
16 other paper product may not be prohibited under this subsection in  
17 any county, or any city or town within such county, in which no  
18 area of the county is designated as a non-attainment area under the  
19 federal clean air act, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 101 et seq.

20 (2) During a forecast, alert, warning or emergency condition  
21 as defined in RCW 70.94.715 or impaired air quality condition as  
22 defined in RCW 70.94.473.

23  
24 Renumber the remaining section consecutively and correct any  
25 internal references accordingly.

**EFFECT:** Allows paper, cardboard, and other paper products to  
be burned in any outdoor residential fire in any county that  
is not designated as non-attainment under the federal Clean  
Air Act.
