

1 **SHB 1135 - H AMD 344 ADOPTED 3/14/95**

2 By Representatives Pennington, McMorris and Talcott

3 On page 2, after line 10 insert the following:

4 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** RCW 28A.335.210 and 1983 c 204 s 7, 1982 c
5 191 s 2, & 1974 ex.s. c 176 s 5 are each repealed.

7 **Sec. 3.** RCW 28B.10.025 and 1990 c 33 s 557 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 The Washington state arts commission shall, in consultation with
10 the boards of regents of the University of Washington and Washington
11 State University and with the boards of trustees of the regional
12 universities, The Evergreen State College, and the community college
13 districts, determine the amount to be made available for the purchases
14 of art under RCW 28B.10.027, and payment therefor shall be made in
15 accordance with law. The designation of projects and sites, the
16 selection, contracting, purchase, commissioning, reviewing of design,
17 execution and placement, acceptance, maintenance, and sale, exchange,
18 or disposition of works of art shall be the responsibility of the
19 Washington state arts commission in consultation with the board of
20 regents or trustees. However, the costs to carry out the Washington
21 state arts commission's responsibility for maintenance shall not be
22 funded from the moneys referred to under this section, RCW 43.17.200,
23 or 43.19.455, ((or 28A.335.210,)) but shall be contingent upon adequate
24 appropriations being made for that purpose.

26 **Sec. 4.** RCW 43.17.205 and 1990 c 33 s 574 are each amended to read
27 as follows:

28 The funds allocated under RCW 43.17.200(~~((, 28A.335.210,))~~) and
29 28B.10.025 shall be subject to interagency reimbursement for
30 expenditure by the visual arts program of the Washington state arts
31 commission when the particular law providing for the appropriation
32 becomes effective. For appropriations which are dependent upon the
33 sale of bonds, the amount or proportionate amount of the moneys under
34 RCW 43.17.200(~~((, 28A.335.210,))~~) and 28B.10.025 shall be subject to
35 interagency reimbursement for expenditure by the visual arts program of
36 the Washington state arts commission thirty days after the sale of a
37 bond or bonds.

39 **Sec. 5.** RCW 43.17.210 and 1990 c 33 s 575 are each amended to read
40 as follows:

41 The Washington state arts commission shall determine the amount to
42 be made available for the purchase of art in consultation with the
43 agency, except where another person or agency is specified under RCW
44 43.19.455(~~((, 28A.335.210,))~~) or 28B.10.025, and payments therefor shall
45 be made in accordance with law. The designation of projects and sites,

1 selection, contracting, purchase, commissioning, reviewing of design,
2 execution and placement, acceptance, maintenance, and sale, exchange,
3 or disposition of works of art shall be the responsibility of the
4 Washington state arts commission in consultation with the directors of
5 the state agencies. However, the costs to carry out the Washington
6 state arts commission's responsibility for maintenance shall not be
7 funded from the moneys referred to in RCW 43.17.200, 43.19.455,
8 ((28A.335.2107)) or 28B.10.025, but shall be contingent upon adequate
9 appropriations being made for that purpose.

11 **Sec. 6.** RCW 43.19.455 and 1990 c 33 s 576 are each amended to read
12 as follows:

13 Except as provided under RCW 43.17.210, the Washington state arts
14 commission shall determine the amount to be made available for the
15 purchase of art under RCW 43.17.200 in consultation with the director
16 of general administration, and payments therefor shall be made in
17 accordance with law. The designation of projects and sites, selection,
18 contracting, purchase, commissioning, reviewing of design, execution
19 and placement, acceptance, maintenance, and sale, exchange, or
20 disposition of works of art shall be the responsibility of the
21 Washington state arts commission in consultation with the director of
22 general administration. However, the costs to carry out the Washington
23 state arts commission's responsibility for maintenance shall not be
24 funded from the moneys referred to under this section, RCW 43.17.200,
25 ((28A.335.2107)) or 28B.10.025, but shall be contingent upon adequate
26 appropriations being made for that purpose."

Correct title accordingly.

EFFECT: Exempts school construction projects from the requirement
that one half of one percent of new construction be set aside for
art.
