7 through "66.44.180." on line 11, and insert "As used in this section  
8 and RCW 66.44.200, "apparently under the influence" means the person  
9 has liquor on his or her breath and has impaired motor skills used for  
10 body control such as walking, standing, and balance. The officer may  
11 also consider other factors including, but not limited to: Slurred  
12 speech, glassy eyes, and poor hand-eye coordination.

13 (4) A violation of this section is a civil infraction punishable by  
14 a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars."
