

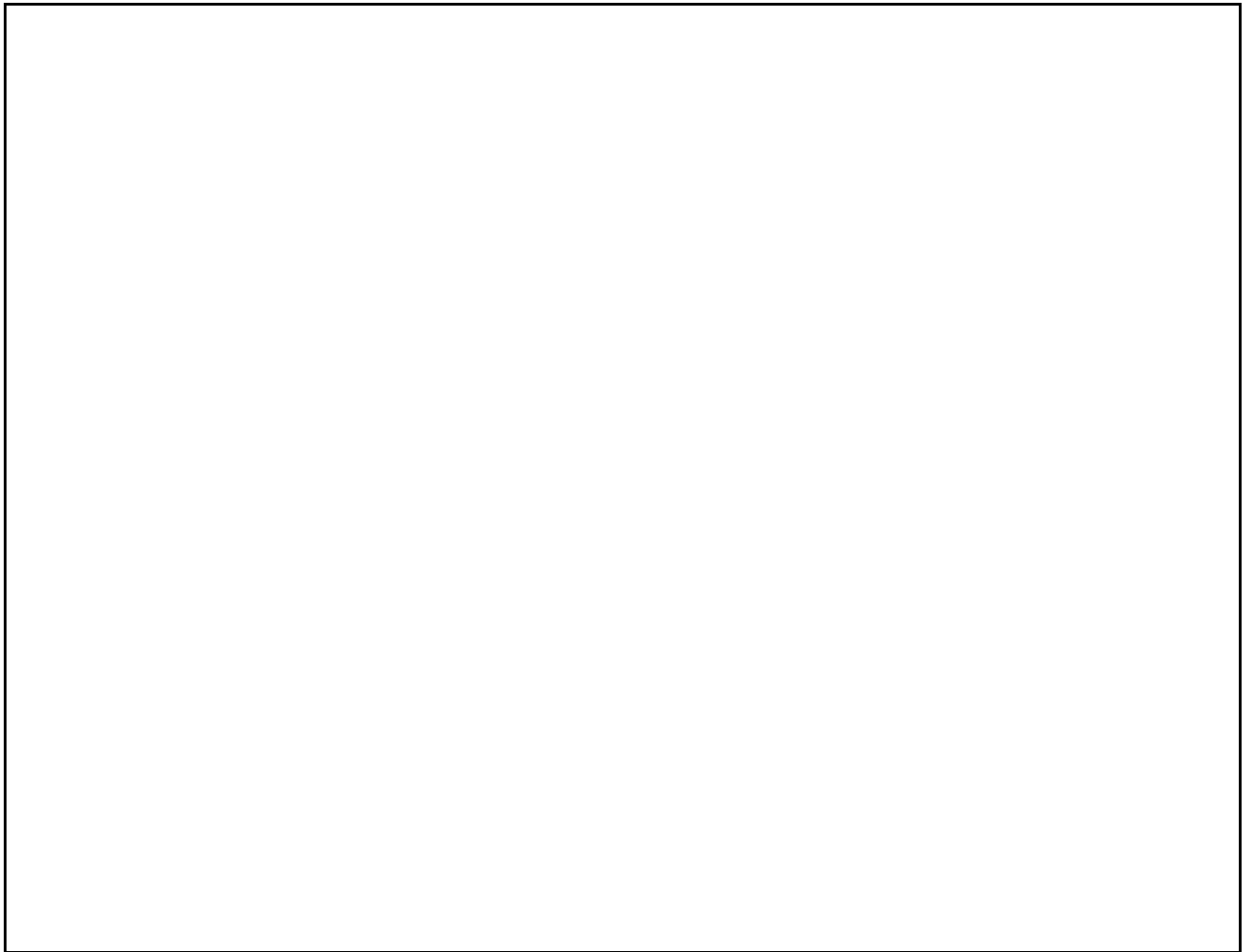

22 appropriation are provided solely for a 4.0 percent cost-of-living  
23 adjustment effective January 1, 1996, and an additional 3.0 percent  
24 cost-of-living adjustment effective January 1, 1997, for all  
25 classified employees (including those employees in the Washington  
26 management service) and exempt employees under the jurisdiction of  
27 the Washington personnel resources board, and commissioned officers  
28 of the Washington state patrol.

29 (2) No salary increase may be paid under this section to any  
30 person whose salary has been Y-rated pursuant to rules adopted by  
31 the Washington personnel resources board.

32 (3) A maximum of \$5,111,000 of the salary/insurance increase  
33 revolving--state appropriation in this section may be expended for

1 salary increases for ferry workers, consistent with the 1995-97  
2 transportation appropriations act."

**EFFECT:** Increases the general fund state appropriation by \$120,862,000: \$28,519,000 GF-S increase for state employee salary increases; and \$92,343,000 GF-S increase for public school employee salary increases. State employees will receive a 4.0 percent salary increase beginning January 1, 1996 and a 3.0 percent salary increase beginning January 1, 1997.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Increases General Fund-State by \$120,862,000.
