8 "(i) \$6,061,000 of the general fund-state appropriation is  
9 provided solely for programs mandated by the legislature as  
10 specified in this sub-section. The superintendent shall adjust  
11 funding, consistent with fiscal notes approved by the office of  
12 financial management and the senate and house of representatives  
13 fiscal committees, for K-12 programs with appropriations from the  
14 general fund-state in Part V of this act with the exception of  
15 subsection (iv). The superintendent will submit a cost estimate of  
16 subsection (iv) to the senate and house of representatives fiscal  
17 committees by December 1, 1995. The amount in this subsection is  
18 provided to implement duties imposed on school districts by:

19 (i) ESHB 1030, an act relating to employment of minors;

20 (ii) 2SHB 1078, an act relating to instruction in Braille;

21 (iii) SHB 1329, an act relating to food and sanitation safety;

22 (iv) E2SHB 1417, an act relating to juveniles;

23 (v) SHB 1677, an act relating to requiring school districts to  
24 obtain an appraisal before purchasing real property;

25 (vi) E2SHB 1941, an act relating to the improvement of reading  
26 literacy;

27 (vii) E2SSB 5439, an act relating to revising procedures for  
28 non-offender at-risk youth and their families; and

29 (viii) SB 5642, an act relating to international exchange  
30 student and teacher program in public schools."
