5 On page 12, after line 22, insert the following:

6 "(c) A caretaker who is a resident of a county in which the average
7 level of unemployment exceeds the average state unemployment by
8 twenty-five percent shall receive unreduced monthly benefit payments
9 while he or she is able and available for work as specified in RCW
10 50.20.010(3) and not employed. Caretakers who move to an eligible area
11 after the effective date of this section are not eligible for this time
12 limit extension."

13 EFFECT: Provides an extension of the time limit for caretakers who
14 are residents of areas with an unemployment rate which exceeds the
15 state average by 25 percent. A caretaker in one of these areas may
16 receive full monthly benefits until employed if he or she complies with
17 unemployment benefit requirements to actively seek work. Caretakers
18 may not move to an eligible area to get the extension.
